## RESOLUTION NO.1 OF 2017

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Clinton County and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, deserve a fair, fully transparent, impartial and depoliticized process for the decennial task of drawing state legislative and congressional districts of near equal population; and

**WHEREAS**, legislative and congressional redistricting has often resulted in the gerrymandering of districts to favor one political party, or political candidate, over another; and

**WHEREAS**, legislation has been introduced to amend the Pennsylvania Constitution to reform the decennial redistricting process via the establishment of an independent citizens redistricting commission; and

**WHEREAS**, such reform of the redistricting process must be acted upon by the General Assembly in a timely fashion to facilitate implementation in conjunction with the next redistricting process in 2021; and


**WHEREAS**, It is imperative the General Assembly of Pennsylvania lay aside all political loyalties and determine the importance and significance of establishing a fair and equitable system to determine state legislative as well as federal congressional districts;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the LOGANTON BOROUGH COUNCIL, does hereby affirm its support for timely action by the state General Assembly on legislative efforts to secure affirmative action on a constitutional amendment that would establish a fair and equitable system to determine legislative and congressional districts which may include an independent citizens redistricting commission; and






