A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEISENBERG, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PLEDGING SUPPORT OF THE PENDING LEGISLATION TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR LEGISLATIVE AND CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING.

WHEREAS, recent legislation has been introduced in the previous and current Pennsylvania legislative sessions to amend the Pennsylvania Constitution to reform the decennial legislative and congressional redistricting process with the intent of using fairness and sound methodology in a non-partisan fashion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Weisenberg Township Board of Supervisors does hereby support legislative efforts to secure expeditious action to make a constitutional amendment that would, among other reforms, assign the decennial task of both legislative and congressional redistricting to an independent citizens commission.
